4. The Priest Of The Eternal Darkness Then Gives A Short Dialogue On The Meaning Of The Hematite Stone

5. The Priest Of The Eternal Light Then Gives A Short Dialogue On The Meaning Of The Quartz Stone

Once The Two Priest Finish The Dialogue Of The Stones They Then Give Orders To Om Members To Put Their Light Necklaces Around Their Necks

Om Members Proceed To Put The Necklace On., The Priest Of The Circle And The Square Then Gives A Member One Of The 50 Names To Recite Simultaneously As He/She Leaves The Square And Walk Around To The Circle From The Back Reciting This Name, The Same Goes On For The Circle He/She Leaves The Circle Reciting A Name Walking Around To The Back Of The Square. This Goes On As Each Member Recite One Of The 99+1 Names Passing Each Other. The Om Members Then End By Saying "Hu" in unison.

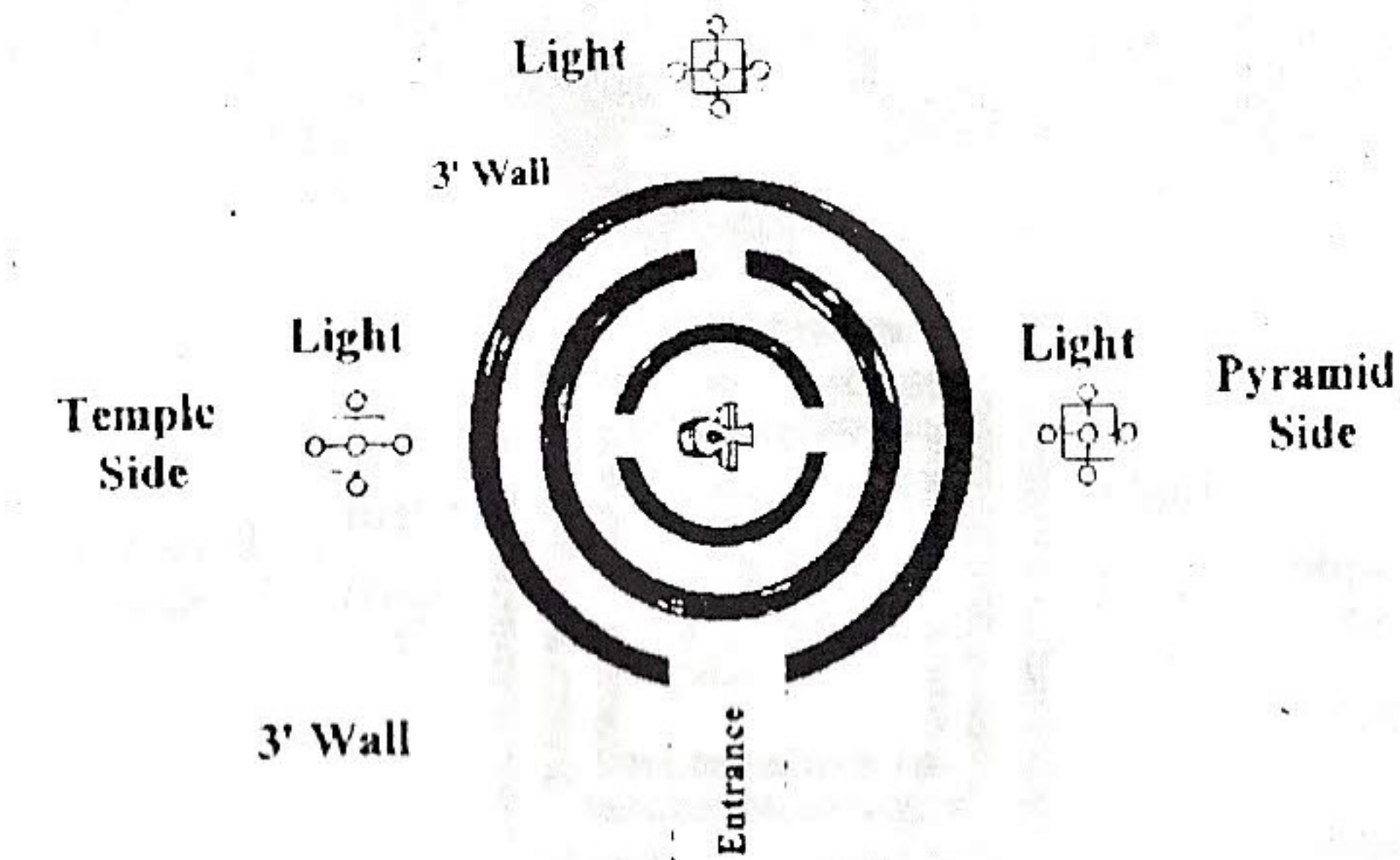
When The Members Are Back Where They Started They Put Their Right Hand Over The Member Next To Them And Put Their Left Arm Over The Shoulders Of The Person To Their Left.

They Begin To Go Around In A Circle Starting With Their Left Feet In Front Of The Right And The Toes Of Each Foot Pointing Outward They Are Also Dipping Or Bowing As They Go Around In A Circle Reciting **KAWUN BINAA ASHUG MINHUM** A Total Of 19 Times.

Then The Om Members Recite The Below A Total Of 19 Times.

**SUBHAANA RABBI ZUL JALAA' SUBHAANA RABBI SUBHAANAKA**

And End In Unison By Om Members Saying **Aummmmm** For 4-7 Seconds, They Then Bow To Each Other With Their Hands Joined Together Bringing The Positive And Negative Together As The Priest Explains The Significance Of What They Are Doing.



### The Ankh Finite Symbol Of Eternal Life

This Symbol Is Used To Represent Eternal Life, This Life Is Referred To As Light. This Symbol Is Also Referred To As The Key To The Next World, The World After This Life Where El And Elohim Becomes One. Light Is Considered Life Because Light Was Created Out Of Darkness. In Which Ra Was There. This Symbol Is Also A Key That Unlocks The Door To Eternal Finite Life. Life Is Considered Or Looked Upon As White Because Life Is Light. This Sacred Symbol Will Be Used Today To Bind The Two Worlds Together, In Principle Of Time Which Is **NOW** Because You Are Living And Dying At The Same Time We Will Start By Saying The Following So The Children Of The White Stone Are Symbolic Of The Light Of The Sun Ra The Seeing
