

TO: PASSPORT APPLICANTS

If You Are Applying For A Nuwaubian Passport For The First Time, You Will Need The Following:

- 1. If You Were Born In U.S.A., A CERTIFIED Copy Of Your Birth Certificate. (The Birth Certificate Must Have Either The Raised Seal Or Rubber Stamp To Show That It Is A Certified Copy And Should Be Obtained From Either The State Health Department Or The Country Registrar Where You Were Born.) If You Are A Foreigner, You Must Have A Birth Certificate Or Other I.D. Green Card.
- 2. Two Passport Photographs (2" X 2", Color). The Background Must Be White Or Off White. The Image Must Measure At Least 1" But Not Over 1 3/8" From Chin To The Top Of The Hair. Do Not Wear No Shades Or Hats. It Is Preferred That These Pictures Be Made By A Professional Photographer.
- 3. Identification Such As Driver's License, Military Id Card, Pilot's License, Green Card Or Current School Id, Birth Certificate, Etc.
- 4. Certified Check Or Money Order For \$25.00 Per Passport Is To Be Made Payable To Nuwaubian Headquarters, P.O. Box 4490, Eatonton Ga., 31024. NO CASH ACCEPTED.
- 5. Children Under The Age Of 13 Years Old, Will Be On Their Parents Passport. If You Have More Than 3 Children, Divide Them Amongst The Mother And Father's Passport. If Separated You Will Need More Than One Passport Specially Stamped.
- 6. A Single Parent With More Than 3 Children Will Be On Their Single Parent Passport.
- 7. A Completed Passport Application Must Be Signed In Your Central Tabernacle In The Presence Of Another Member Of The Nuwaubian Nation Of Moors.

Passport Applications Are Admitted To Your Central Tabernacle Or Mailed To The Holy Tabernacle Ministries Inc. At P.O. Box 4490, Eatonton, Georgia 31024. Your Central Tabernacle Is A Designated Place To Accept Passport Applications And To Forward To The Nuwaubian Headquarters For Processing.
